The **Safeguarding team** at St Wilfrid's provide help, advice and guidance to parents and pupils. We work with a number of agencies in school that provide confidential services to our school community.

School nursing - Offer a drop in service pupils every Monday lunchtime in Meeting Room 1 .The school nurse service offer advice and guidance on Keeping Healthy, immunisations, emotional Health , Weight Management, Sexual Health and Drugs and Alcohol.

The Service is provided by a qualified School Nurse or Specialist community public health nurses. Pupils can use the drop in service or be referred for a private appointment through Safeguarding team.

Education Welfare – Our Education Welfare officer is Deborah Barker and she can be contacted on 01977 691000 ext 290 on a Wednesday and Thursday. Main office 01924 307451. Education Welfare Advise parents on your rights and responsibilities of school attendance. We can also signpost to other services were families need welfare advice.

Catholic Care – We have two Catholic Care workers Graham Robertson and Sharon Wicks, who are in school three days a week. Catholic care offer a School-based counselling to support children and young people with mental health issues.
